We write to convey our support for Denver Water's License Amendment Application for the Gross Reservoir Expansion Project.

Gross Reservoir, as part of the broader Moffat Collection System, is a critical component of Colorado's water infrastructure. With Colorado being one of the fastest growing states in the country and the Denver metropolitan area home to some of the fastest growing cities, it is essential we are taking steps now to meet our state's water and energy needs. Expanding Gross Reservoir to allow for increased water storage will assist Denver Water in meeting the needs of millions of Coloradans dependent on the utility for their water.



Thank you for your consideration and we look forward to your response.


